

Supply List for Orchestra Students

Here are the supplies that Orchestra students need in order to fully participate in Orchestra:

All students need to have a black 3 ring binder for music. One inch binder with inside pockets works best. The binder must be clearly labeled with the student's name on the front!

Violinists and violists: the instrument you use at school must have:

1. your name on your case
2. your name on your bow and on instrument (under chin rest works best)
3. a fresh set of strings on your instrument. Change your strings if they are more than 1 year old. Refer to the Handbook for recommended brands and vendors an extra set of strings in case one breaks during class: you may use your old set of strings for this purpose
4. rosin: refer to the Handbook for recommended brands and vendors
5. cleaning cloth –a soft cotton rag works best

Violinists and violists: the instrument you use at home must have:

1. your name on your case
2. a fresh set of strings on your instrument. Change your strings if they are more than 1 year old. Refer to the Handbook for recommended brands and vendors
3. an extra set of strings in your case: you may use your old set of strings for this purpose
4. rosin: refer to the Handbook for recommended brands and vendors
5. cleaning cloth –a soft cotton rag works best

Cello and bass players: you can use school instruments for class. The instrument you use at home must have:

1. your name on your case
2. a fresh set of strings on your instrument. Change your strings if they are more than 1 year old. Refer to the Handbook for recommended brands and vendors
3. an extra set of strings in your case: you may use your old set of strings
4. rosin: refer to the Handbook for recommended brands and vendors
5. cleaning cloth –a soft cotton rag works best

You will need to bring your instrument to school for all dress rehearsals and all performances

Pianists: you can use school instruments for class. Make sure to have your piano at home tuned at least once a year
